STATEMENT OF CONCERN NO. 28909 **GOLDENKEY OIL INC.** PROPOSED WELLS LOCATIONS: 05-14-008-22W4M & 16-16-008-22W4M

The Alberta Energy Regulator (AER) acknowledges receipt of your letter dated March 26, 2014, indicating your statement of concern to the proposed application. Please be advised that an application for the proposed wells has not been received by the AER to date. Your statement of concern has been entered into the AER database and the system will track your statement of concern. Your statement of concern will expire on March 26, 2015 and will be closed from the system without further communication, unless it is linked to an active application prior to that date.

The AER expects parties to discuss their concerns. By way of copy of this letter, and your correspondence, to Goldenkey Oil Inc. (Goldenkey), we are requesting Goldenkey to address your concerns. If Goldenkey is unable to resolve your concerns, the AER will require Goldenkey to note your concerns and indicate all of the communications that have taken place between both parties upon submitting their application.

Please note that the AER has no jurisdiction over matters of compensation for land usage. The Alberta Surface Rights Board is the regulatory agency that deals with these issues. Further the AER has no jurisdiction with respect to assessing the adequacy of Crown consultation with the rights of aboriginal peoples.

The AER offers and strongly recommends you make use of our Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) program which features either staff or third party mediation arranged through an AER mediator.
