MOVE-OUT GUIDE

INTRODUCTION: MOVING OUT

This guide has all the information you need to know about moving out of Residence.

- The last day to move-out is Friday, December 20th by 4 pm.
- If you are found staying past that date, you will be charged \$150.00 for the first night, and a daily room rate commencing the second night until you have vacated the unit. Late move-out charges will apply.
- If you are moving out during office hours M F between 9 am - 12 pm & 1 pm - 4 pm please:
 - Drop off your white access card to the Housing Services office in UHall C420
- If you move out outside of office hours, please:
 - Place your white access card in an envelope provided with your name, room # and date of move out, and place it in the mailslot outside the Housing Services Office in the UHall C420 hallway
 - Send us an email notifying us that you have moved out
- Lost access cards will be charged \$75.




IMPORTANT:

- Late Move-Outs: Late move-out charges will apply and there is NO opportunity to extend your stay.
- **Storage Areas:** Ensure all personal belongings are removed. Be sure to check all storage areas in your suites.
- **Phone & Internet Connection:** Please ensure your in-room phone is properly plugged in and working prior to move-out.
- **Secure your space:** As you leave your room for the last time, please ensure that the window is closed and your door is locked.
- **Linens:** If you are an international student you must leave all assigned bedding on the bed, otherwise, it will be assumed to be "missing," resulting in additional costs to you. Shower curtains belonging to Housing Services must be machine-washed and hung to dry. Do not put it in the dryer.

Plan ahead for a smoother move-out

Planning ahead can make your move-out process quick and stress-free. Start by organizing your belongings early, scheduling cleaning tasks, and ensuring all personal items are packed before your move-out date. Check our checklist to avoid last-minute surprises and enjoy a smoother transition!

MOVE-OUT GUIDE CLEANING YOUR SPACE/UNIT

Residents are responsible for their own bedrooms, as well as, shared areas such as kitchens, bathrooms, and common rooms.

Plan ahead as vacuums are a scarce commodity. If incomplete, you will incur additional expenses.

Do NOT attempt to make your own repairs to walls, etc. This may result in additional costs to you.

Sit down with your roommate(s) and have a conversation about your exam schedule and when you plan to move out. Ensure you maintain communication through final exams, especially as you move out, to ensure that all the cleaning that was agreed to has been completed.

Take photos of your unit when you have moved out. This way, should a dispute arise or a roommate moves out and leaves a mess, there is evidence of the cleaning that was completed and the state of the unit at that time.

Please remember: if we are forced to charge for cleaning, replacement parts, damage, or labour, a \$10.00 administration fee will also be assessed to recover office and processing expenses.

Please note:

- If housekeeping needs to do additional cleaning: Cleaning fees will be assessed at \$50.00 per hour. Cleaning charges assessed for common areas, kitchens, and bathrooms will be divided among roommates.
- As you are leaving:
 - Make sure to take all your belongings.
 - Unclaimed items will be donated to a local charity after 30 days.
 - Remember to close your window, and turn off lights.
 - Email Housing Services (housing@uleth.ca) to notify you have vacated the unit.
- Please return your access card to the Housing Services office in person during office hours or via envelope through the C420 mail slot for after hours. If your card is lost, a \$75 charge will be applied.

MOVE-OUT GUIDE INSTITUTIONAL PROPERTY

Residents are responsible for the general condition of the room, suite area, furniture, and fixtures. Inventory stickers, VOIP phones, and handsets (they will not work off campus), and fire extinguishers must not be removed.

Housing Services is the only one that can authorize, conduct, and manage maintenance, repairs, and replacements. This is done to ensure the work is completed properly, to the extent necessary, and in line with the University's quality and integrity standards. As such, do not attempt to maintain or repair any damage, vandalism, messes, etcetera, that has resulted from your actions. This includes but is not limited to repairing holes, doors, walls, shelves, leaks, etc. You will held responsible for the costs of labour and materials to undo and redo the work.

Costs for labour and material to clean, maintain, repair, or replace damage, vandalism, messes, etc. will be charged to those found responsible by Housing Services and/or the ORS Council. If a responsible party cannot be determined, charges will be split between the residence students of the applicable unit, floor, section, building, or ORS.

Costs for labour and notable materials are on Page 6. They are based on an established list of costs, as approved by the University of Lethbridge Board of Governors. All prices are subject to change without notice and any items not listed will be assessed at the item/material costs plus 10%. Please note, that a **\$100 Cleaning Fee** will be applicable if there is evidence of smoking or vaping indoors, preparing cannabis edibles, or pet(s).

An administration charge of \$10.00 will be applied to each charge notice assessed.
