- Successful completion of a minimum of 20 courses (60.0 credit hours) towards the B.B.A./LL.B. or the B.Mgt./LL.B.
- GPA 2.70 (calculated on all courses completed at the U of L)
- Students may be conditionally approved pending completion of Winter term courses
