Students are responsible for familiarizing themselves with program requirements and regulations outlined in the University of Lethbridge Calendar including, but not limited to:

**Minimum Grade Requirement**

A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in Statistics 1770; Economics 1010 and Economics 1012; Writing 1000 or English 1900; all Dhillon School of Business courses, including courses cross-listed with Dhillon School of Business courses (ACCT, AGEM, FINC, HRLR, IGBM, IMGT, MGT, and MKTG); and all courses in the major marked with an asterisk (\*) in order to meet degree requirements.

**Time Limit for Degree**

All degree requirements must be completed within 10 years after acceptance into the Dhillon School of Business.

**Residence Requirement**

Students must successfully complete 10 3000/4000-level Dhillon School of Business courses at the U of L. Accounting and Finance majors have additional residence requirements (see academic calendar). Economics and Political Science majors can use unspecified 3000/4000 ECON and POLI courses respectively taken at the U of L toward the Dhillon School of Business residence requirement.

### Degree Requirements

**At least 50 courses with:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ a minimum grade point average of 2.00 in the 30 courses from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science, Faculty of Fine Arts, and School of Liberal Education
- \_\_\_\_\_ a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00 and a minimum graduation grade point average of 2.00
- \_\_\_\_\_ a minimum grade of 'C-' is required in Statistics 1770; Economics 1010 and Economics 1012; Writing 1000 or English 1900; all Dhillon School of Business courses, including courses cross-listed with Dhillon School of Business courses; and all courses in the major marked with an asterisk

**B.A. or B.Sc. degree requirements:**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Not more than 10 courses may be completed at the 1000 level (or lower) for credit towards the degrees, excluding Activity courses (labelled PHAC and MUSE) and courses numbered in the range of 0520 to 0530.
- \_\_\_\_\_ At least 10 courses from disciplines offered by the Faculty of Arts and Science, Faculty of Fine Arts, or School of Liberal Education at the 3000/4000 level, excluding Activity courses (labelled PHAC and MUSE).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Not more than three Independent Study courses (9.0 credit hours) may be completed for credit towards the degree.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Not more than three Disciplinary Credit Applied Studies courses (9.0 credit hours) may be completed for credit towards the degree. Students may, in addition, complete Applied Studies 2000, 2001, 2010, and 2011.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Not more than 17 courses (51.0 credit hours) may be completed from any one discipline for credit towards the degree (See **Arts and Science, Arts and Science Disciplines**)\*.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Not more than six credit hours in Activity courses (i.e. courses labelled PHAC and MUSE; maximum 6.0 credit hours) EXCEPT: Kinesiology majors - maximum of 15.0 credit hours  
Music majors - maximum of 12.0 credit hours

**Complete an Arts and Science or Fine Arts major, and a Dhillon School of Business major:**

**Fulfill the University of Lethbridge Residence Requirement and meet the Time Limit of the Dhillon School of Business:**

\*Disciplines are identified by a specific course label (e.g. KNES, ASTR, and HIST are separate disciplines).

**Note:** Students seeking the B.A./B.Mgt. or B.Sc./B.Mgt. degrees may not declare similar majors. For example, if Economics, Indigenous Studies, or Political Science is chosen for the B.A./B.Mgt. portion of the B.A./B.Mgt. program, Economics, Indigenous Governance and Business Management, or Political Science respectively must be excluded from the list of B.Mgt. majors.

**Completion of the Liberal Education List Requirement (Lib Ed Requirement)**

Only four courses (12.0 credit hours) in total may be counted from any one discipline toward the Lib Ed Requirement. Disciplines are identified by separate course subject codes.

Only four courses (12.0 credit hours) in total from the Faculty of Education (EDUC), Faculty of Health Sciences (ABHL, ADCS, HLSC, NURS, PUBH, and TREC), and the Dhillon School of Business (ACCT, AGEM, FINC, HRLR, IGBM, IMGT, MGT, and MKTG) may be counted towards the Lib Ed Requirement.
