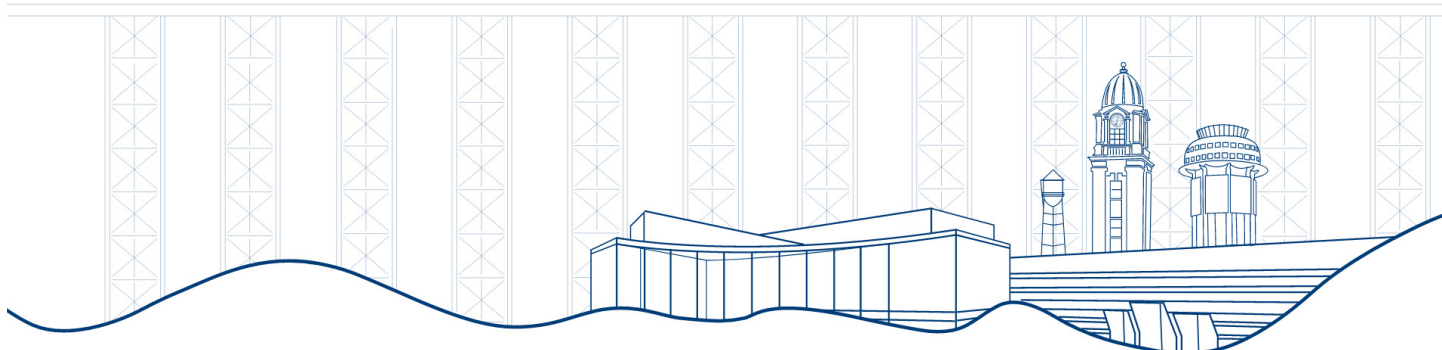

- _____ Attain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 (on the University of Lethbridge 4.0 scale) on all required Addictions Counselling, Health Sciences, Indigenous Health, and Public Health courses taken for credit towards the degree.
- _____ Completion of two courses from each of Lists I, II, and III for the Liberal Education List Requirement (see **School of Liberal Education** in the 2025/2026 University of Lethbridge Calendar, www.ulethbridge.ca/ross/academic-calendar).
- _____ Not more than three Independent Study courses may be taken for credit towards the degree.
- _____ Residence requirement: 20 courses (60 credit hours).
- _____ All degree requirements must be completed within seven years of completion of the first required course offered by the Faculty of Health Sciences.
